R&M implemented office cabling in Hong Kong for the Horwath Hong Kong Group, one of the most successful accounting and management consulting networks in the world.

Horwath Hong Kong Group is the Asian Headquarters of Horwath International, which has a network of more than 110 independent financial and management consulting firms with over 420 offices in 90 countries and 400 cities worldwide. The commercial group with its approximately 18,500 partners and employees provides consulting in many different areas, such as organization, financing, insurance, risk management, taxes and technology. The member firms of the Horwath network are consistently leaders in their home markets.

Innovative by tradition

The company history goes back almost one hundred years. Horwath & Horwath was established in 1915. At the time, the two Horwath brothers recognized the

potential of a special accounting system for the tourism sector which they then developed. The system is still used by many hotels. The Horwath firm used its success in this niche sector to additionally develop expertise in the areas of tax consulting, franchising and financing.

In many aspects, Horwath was a pioneer in the Chinese market. The company was the first international group whose member firms were allowed to pursue their activities in China with approval from the Chinese Ministry of Finance. This permitted Horwath to develop a presence in China that is unique with regard to countrywide experience, as well as with respect to international importance. The offices in China are well established locally and employ many highly skilled specialists. Horwath China is one of the largest accounting networks in the country with offices in Beijing, Shanghai, Dalian, Wuhan, Qingdao and Nanjing. The offices in Beijing and Shanghai are the most important firms in their sector in these cities.

Optimally networked headquarters

Horwath Hong Kong is the headquarters for the Asia-Pacific region. Among the company's customers are corporations in China and overseas, business partnerships in many varied sectors, as well as public organizations. In Hong Kong, Horwath has its offices in one of the tallest and most renowned office buildings in the city, the Central Plaza.

R&M China, only present in the Chinese market for a short time, was able to convince Horwath and implemented a Cat. 6 network with unshielded cabling (Cat. 6 UTP). 300 Cat. 6 modules and 15 patch panels each with 24 ports were installed. The system is well-implemented and Horwath Hong Kong is optimally equipped for additional growth and future success.
